## TIP

Remember to list your preferences in order of what you're most passionate about, not based on your ATAR. How you preference is how SATAC will provide offers (by working down the list). In your SATAC application, make sure you use your own mobile number and a personal email address — one you can access after high school.

And, don't forget to apply before the early application deadline to avoid a late fee.

## CHECK AND CONFIRM

Year 12 results are finalised in mid-December. Check to see if you're eligible for Adjustment Factors (bonus points) and confirm your Selection Rank (ATAR, including Adjustment Factors), by visiting SATAC's self-service portal. Then, give our Future Students Enquiries team a call to talk through your study options.

You could be eligible for UniSA's Guaranteed Entry into your preferred degree through your Selection Rank, Year 12 subject grades or TAFE/VET qualification (see page 2).

It's also important to confirm your preferences by the change of preference deadline to be considered for an offer.

Remember to pay your SATAC application fee. If you don't, you won't be eligible to receive an offer.
