Apply

Armed with your list of preferences, you can now apply to study at UniSA through the SATAC website. If you need help with your application, check out our self-help resources.

Tip: Apply to SATAC using your own mobile number and a personal email address — one you can access after high school.

Remember to list your preferences in order of what you're most passionate about. SATAC will work down your list of preferences so it's important to order based on what you would like to study most, not your ATAR.

3 August 2020: SATAC applications open.
30 September 2020: Early application deadline.
1 December 2020: Equal consideration deadline.

Check and confirm

Year 12 results are in and you may be eligible for Adjustment Factors. Login to your SATAC application to confirm your Selection Rank (ATAR + Adjustment Factors) then call us to talk through your study options.

Also, check to see if you're eligible for Guaranteed Entry into your preferred UniSA degrees. The best place to start is our online ATAR > Degree Finder.

It's important to confirm your preferences by the change of preference deadline to be considered for an offer in the main January offer round.

Tip: Remember to pay your SATAC application fee. If you don't you won't be eligible to receive an offer.

The main offer round in January will consider all preferences. For some degrees, applicants who have not received the Selection Rank required may be offered a place based on the grades of their Year 12 subjects.
