Bachelor of Film and Television

As part of the Bachelor of Film and Television Visual Effects Specialisation, students can spend the entire third year of the degree studying on location at the Rising Sun Pictures studio*. Students will receive practical training in the core skills of entry-level visual effects artists, produce an industry-standard show reel of work, and establish valuable industry networks.

Graduate Certificate in Dynamic Effects and Lighting

This course is a 12-week intensive program in which students are immersed within a simulated studio environment. They are provided with the necessary theoretical and practical skills to produce complex visual effects. Students will learn 3D visual effects techniques such as dynamic effects (particle-based simulations such as explosions, water effects, textural effects,

clouds); procedurally generated environments (such as cities, beaches and forests); and computer generated lighting applications.

Graduate Certificate in Compositing and Tracking

This course is a 12-week intensive program in which students are immersed within a simulated studio environment. They learn professional practices in compositing and tracking, and are provided the theory, skills and techniques to produce industry-standard visual effects based film sequences.

Bachelor of Film and Television

Entry Requirements

Meet any prerequisite requirements with a minimum grade of C- or equivalent

AND

Qualify for the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE), and achieved a competitive Selection Rank (ATAR), or

Complete secondary qualifications equivalent to SACE, or

Complete the International Baccalaureate Diploma with a minimum score of 24 points

Applicants who have not achieved the Selection Rank required for automatic selection may be selected for any remaining places based on the grades of their year 12 subjects.

Entry Requirements

Applicants seeking entry to the program will have:

completed a three-year Bachelor degree from a recognised higher education institution in media arts or VFX

or

completed a related discipline or completed an Advanced Diploma in Screen and Media or equivalent from an accredited registered training organisation

or

relevant industry experience as deemed equivalent by the University of South Australia.

All applicants must submit a showreel of their own work and a curriculum vitae outlining their relevant experience.
