Take your first step towards a career as a commercial pilot.

We offer a highly-flexible flying program with three distinct pathway options.

All students apply for and start in the **Bachelor of Aviation (Flight)**.

Within the first semester, you may apply for PATHWAY 1, our flagship program that includes a full suite of licences and ratings to make you entry level airline-ready.

Successful students into this pathway will graduate with a **Bachelor of Aviation (Pilot)** and **Graduate Diploma in Aviation**.

Other students may prefer PATHWAYS 2 or 3, which include a taste of flying (15-20 hours) in the bachelor degree, followed by optional CPL qualification.

Please note that studying a bachelor and pilot licence at the same time is a challenging workload.
