

## Year 12 Grades Guaranteed Entry

UniSA offers guaranteed entry based on your three best Year 12 subject grades for most degrees. If you achieve the selection grades and you put us as your first preference, that's it, you're automatically in.

*Subjects need to be 20-credit Stage 2 Tertiary Admission Subjects (TAS). Students also need to achieve a minimum ATAR of 50. Check out the admissions chart at the back of this brochure to see the selection grades needed for the degrees that interest you most.*

## Selection Rank Guaranteed Entry

UniSA has set guaranteed entry scores for most of our degrees. This means, that if you achieve that set Selection Rank and you put us as your first preference, you're in. There's nothing more you have to do.

*Some degrees also have prerequisites and other eligibility criteria for entry that you'll still have to meet. This is for both Year 12 Grades Guaranteed Entry and Selection Rank Guaranteed Entry.*

## TAFE/VET Guaranteed Entry


If you have successfully completed the set TAFE/VET qualification for your preferred UniSA degree, you'll automatically receive an offer.

## Remember your bonus points

Don't forget that high school students applying for university can also be eligible for Adjustment Factors (previously known as bonus points). These are based on set equity factors and/or subject choices. They're automatically added to your ATAR, giving you a more competitive Selection Rank score.
