3. **What hands-on training will I require?** (i.e. computer, medical, legal, trades).
4. **What people and resources can help me to achieve my career goals?** (i.e. work experience, volunteering, teachers, career advisers, counsellors, student organisations, universities, TAFE, trade schools, internet, parents, relatives, mentors.)
